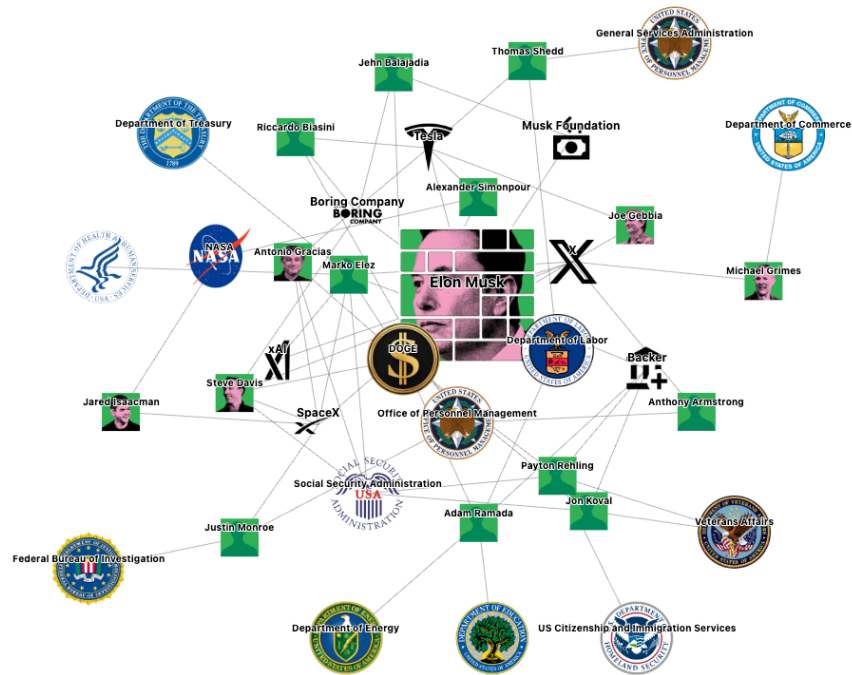

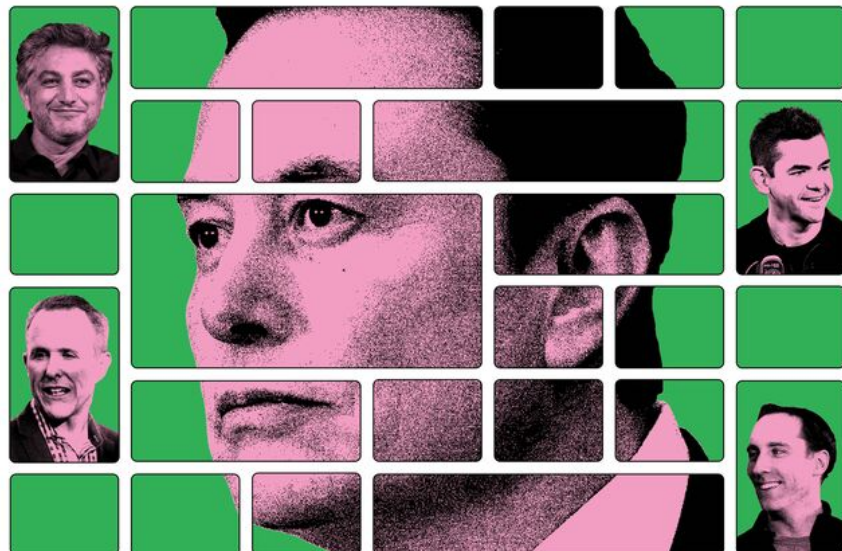
Dream Small / Visualization of Elon Musk's DOGE network
